Died on his 84th birthday
Scored 37 goals for Sittingbourne in the Kent League during his one season there
Was transferred to Leicester Fosse for £90 shortly after they had beaten the Common in the F.A. Cup, although he played in neither game as he was cup-tied
Scored a goal on his Leicester Fosse debut, away to Bristol City on 10.2.1912, and followed it two days later with all four goals in a friendly at Merthyr
Was Leicester Fosse's top scorer in the 1911-12 season despite only playing 12 matches
Transferred to Tottenham Hotspur for £90 the day after they beat Leicester Fosse in the F.A. Cup (2-0 after a 5-5 draw) having played centre forward in both matches
Scored twice on his Tottenham Hotspur debut
Also played in 8 other matches for Tottenham Hotspur, scoring 7 goals
Had a prolific scoring record at Margate, with 27 goals in 25 (or 26) matches in 1919-20 and 6 goals in between 12 and 15 appearances in 1920-21
Became coach of Margate Juniors (not directly linked to Margate) for the 1922-23 season, but the club folded after two months
Was an issuer to the RASC in 1939
